With just 52 handcrafted flatbed leather seats to the exclusive in-flight amenities, the Four Seasons Private Jet makes the journey and destination truly unique.

If you are looking for a luxury travel experience at 40,000 feet above the ground with your private attendant, check out Four Seasons' fully branded jet – Boeing 757. The hotel industry's first endeavour, this aircraft has been customized from nose to tail - with guests in mind, beginning with the remarkably spacious interior. With only 52 seats arranged 2x2, each passenger is provided with a generous 6.5 feet (2 metres) of personal space. Handcrafted in Italy and designed exclusively for Four Seasons, the soft leather seats can recline to a fully flat position, and each one is outfitted with a Mongolian cashmere blanket. Crisp white linens and goose-down pillows are readily provided for those wanting to sleep between destinations.

SERVED IN STYLE ON-BOARD

The on-board journey team includes the Four Seasons Director of Guest Experience, Four Seasons Concierge, Journey Manager, Assistant Journey Manager, Private Jet Chef and an on-board physician. In addition, the cabin and flight crews are all fully Four Seasons-trained to meet every need in flight.

DESIGNED DESTINATIONS

The destinations are all pre planned and specially curated for each journey. Initially, Four Seasons first offered private jet journeys that focused exclusively on stays at Four Seasons properties worldwide in 2012. In 2015, the experience evolved to trips aboard a custom-designed Four Seasons Private Jet.

The current Private Jet journeys are fully immersive Four Seasons experiences from the moment a guest books their trip to the moment they return home. From itinerary planning and car transfers, to luggage services and visas – it's a smooth process. The company began with two Four Seasons Private Jet journeys a year and in 2017, due to popular demand, added a third itinerary to operate in 2018. Then came the World of Adventures itinerary!

For 2019, International Intrigue and Timeless Encounters are on waitlist and a fourth journey was added to the 2019 Four Seasons Private Jet lineup. The coveted World of Adventures is now available alongside Latin Escape for 2019.

For instance Timeless Encounters 2019 includes a day at the iconic Taj Mahal while enroute to Dubai and World of Adventures 2019 offers a Samurai Sword fighting lesson with Tetsuro Shimaguchi, head choreographer for the movie Kill Bill: Volume One. Another highlight is the three-night trip in the Galápagos Islands on a private ship, allowing travellers to wake up each day in a new location.

The itineraries themselves are flexible, allowing legs to be re-routed and accommodations adjusted should there be the need to do so. Suggestions are given as these are specially curated itineraries. INTERNATIONAL INTRIGUE (FEBRUARY 15 – MARCH 9, 2020)

Seattle - Kyoto - Hôï An - Maldives - Serengeti - Marrakech - Budapest - St. Petersburg - Paris

Kicking off the 2020 line-up, travellers will take flight across four continents to visit thrilling cities and remote islands in celebration



of vibrant cultures around the world. Adventurers will explore old Japan in Kyoto, discover the ancient temples of Hôï An in Vietnam, relax on pristine Maldives beaches, and taste the exotic flavours of Morocco. Jetsetters will also be witness to Serengeti sunsets and can enjoy a soak or two when visiting Budapest's historic baths. A behind-the-scenes ballet experience awaits travellers in St. Petersburg before a final stop in the City of Light for a three-Michelin-starred farewell.



TIMELESS ENCOUNTERS (MARCH 12 - APRIL 4, 2020)

Kona - Bora Bora – Sydney – Bali - Chiang Mai - Taj Mahal - Dubai - Prague - London

Over 24 days, travellers will relax on tranquil islands and celebrate one of the world's most iconic architectural wonders. Beginning in Hawaii, Four Seasons Private Jet guests will then jet off to picture perfect Bora Bora, before making their way to Australia for a backstage tour of the Sydney Opera House. Bali's jungles are next on the roster, ahead of a private Thai cooking lesson in Chiang Mai. On the way to Dubai, a quick stop in Agra for the day gives guests the chance to explore the legendary Taj Mahal. A private concert at the only remaining theatre where Mozart performed is on offer in Prague, and a final stop in London has new friends sailing down the Thames by twilight.

observation. When visiting the Galápagos Islands, guests will cruise through the crystal-clear waters of the remote archipelago, spending three nights aboard an exclusively chartered ship. The journey concludes in Miami, giving guests ample opportunity to explore the Magic City's diverse arts scene.
